

pertaining to the articles and any of the other events listed on the addendum.

4. After distribution of the waivers, the parties will agree among themselves to a deposition schedule. However, the discovery authorized by this Order shall be completed by April 22, 2005. It is further

ORDERED that within two weeks from the date of this Order, the parties shall submit a proposed protective order with respect to current and former government personnel that were excluded from the list of personnel previously provided to the plaintiff on Lists A and B.¹ In the event the parties fail to come to agreement with respect to the proposed protective order, the parties shall submit separate proposed orders to the Court for its consideration.
